【Information】Regarding Launch of Advance Declaration System(PACT) for Cargo Bound for Canada

Thank you for your continued support for JALCARGO.

Now, the Canada authorities have notified us that they will launch a new security program “PRE-LOAD AIR CARGO TARGETING (below PACT)” from NOV 2024.

PACT is a new cargo information advance declaration system being introduced by the Canada authorities to strengthen air cargo security. Airlines must submit advance cargo information (FWB/FHL) to the Canada authorities and obtain permission before loading onto aircraft (same system as US ACAS and European ICS2). We would like to inform you about the program requirements as follows and your understanding along with cooperation is highly appreciated.

1. **Target Shipments**

All shipments bound for or transit via Canada.
✕Cargo arriving in Canada by land (truck) is not eligible.

2. **Valid Date**

From 07OCT 2024 (MON)
✕Prior to the full-scale implementation of PACT, we will start from 07OCT and thank you for your cooperation. Regarding the actual implementation date, we will notify you separately.

3. **Request Details**

Since it is necessary to obtain loading permission from the Canada authorities before loading, please provide accurate information by the submission time.

The data to be submitted has not changed from the previous content and please refer to JALCARGO-INFO (Providing accurate cargo information under the advance declaration system US/Canada) announced in MAY 2024 to ensure that accurate information is provided.

If you apply to PACT by yourself, please be sure to check the Shipment Permit (SF) when tender the cargo and please indicate that PACT has been completed in the Handling Information of MAWB.

-AWB Example-

(Name of Agent) has transmitted HAWB Data directly to Canada authorities, and has received SF approval without any problems.

4. **Others**

The cargo may be offload without prior notice if loading permission is not obtained from the Canada authorities.

Additionally, please understand that the customer may be responsible for the costs if the Canada authorities impose a fine for incur additional charge due to incomplete information.
